This call for abstracts is directed to interested participants to share their clinical practice, education, leadership and research topics at the CAAPN 2011 Biennial conference. Presentations may be either Oral sessions (30 minute) or Poster presentations.

The conference incorporates the following themes:

- Practice informing research, education, leadership and administration.
- Research exploring practice, education, leadership and administration.
- Education influencing practice, research leadership and administration.
- Leadership and administration guiding research, practice and education.

The conference will attract advanced practice nurses; both nurse practitioners and clinical nurse specialists, as well as other health professionals from across Canada. Participants will represent the realms of clinical practice, education, regulation, leadership and policy. A stimulating program is planned with speakers who are prominent leaders in health care. We invite you to share your work in areas including innovative models of care, education program innovations, nursing and health leadership and policy issues.

Guidelines for Abstract Submission

- Indicate the theme to which your abstract applies and outline how your work is related to the theme
- Abstract summary must be submitted online in Word document format to CAAPN2011Abstracts@gmail.com
- An individual may submit more than one abstract. One official submission form is required for each abstract.
- Indicate if you wish to be considered for an oral presentation or poster presentation.
- There is no fee to submit abstract(s).
- Submission Deadline: **February 15, 2011**

- Successful applicants will be notified by email no later than February 27, 2011
- Applicants not accepted for oral presentations may be offered the option of a poster presentation
- Successful applicants must confirm their acceptance by March 17, 2011

Abstract Format

1. Title of presentation
2. Choice of Oral or Poster session
3. Author name(s) and organization name(s). Specify primary presenter's name
4. Street address, city, province, postal code, telephone number, fax number & email address of all presenters
5. Provide an introduction to the topic, the problem(s) being addressed, investigations, outcomes and pertinent "take home messages"
6. Each submission is to be 250 words or less (excluding author information)
